Notice is hereby given that on 18th October 1972 the Secretary of State for the Environment amended the above Development Plan.

A certified copy of the amended Development Plan together with the Inspector's Report have been deposited at the Cudworth Urban District Council Offices, Barnsley Road, Cudworth, the Hemsworth Rural District Council Offices, Brierley Hall, Brierley, near Barnsley, the County Planning Office, Raines House, Denby Dale Road, Wakefield and at the Area Planning Office, 70 Vernon Road, Worsbrough Bridge, near Barnsley.

The copies of the Development Plan and Inspector's Report so deposited will be open for inspection free of charge by all persons interested between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. each weekday except Saturday.

The amendment became operative as from 19th May 1973 but if any persons aggrieved by it desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within six weeks from 19th May 1973, make application to the High Court.—Dated 19th May 1973.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971 (Section 210)

*Wolverhampton County Borough Council (Footpath at
Broad Lane North, Wednesfield) (Footpath Number 30)
Diversion Order 1973*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 11th May 1973, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Wolverhampton as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the public right of way running from a point on Broad Lane North 140 yards north of Perry Hall canal bridge to a point 145 yards therefrom in an easterly direction to a line running from a point 50 yards north of the said Perry Hall canal bridge in an easterly direction for 67 yards, then continuing in a northerly direction for a distance of 134 yards then in an easterly direction for a distance of 50 yards joining up with the said original public right of way.
