The London-Holyhead Trunk Road (Gorad Crossroads Improvement Side Roads) Order 197

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the above mentioned Trunk Road at Valley in the County of Anglesey to make under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 an Order which will:
