

(b) The conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from premises.

(c) The purpose of agriculture or building operations.

(d) The maintenance of the roads, and telegraphic lines, and the supply of gas, electricity and water.

The Derbyshire County Council (Coronation Street, Whitwell) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1973

The County of Devon (Lakeside, Salcombe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that on 6th June 1973 the Devon County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When this Order comes into effect on 11th June 1973, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time from 1st May to 30th September each year on the east side of Lakeside, Salcombe.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;
- (c) collecting or delivering postal packets for the Post Office;
- (d) the maintenance of the road; and
- (e) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the length of road in question may be examined during usual office hours, Monday to Friday, at the offices of the Urban District Council, Salcombe, or at Room G.33, County Hall, Exeter.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 6th June 1973, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The County of Devon (Ashcombe Cross, A.380/B.3192 Interim Improvement Scheme) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1973.

Notice is hereby given that on 6th June 1973 the Devon County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When the Order comes into operation on 11th June 1973, you will not be allowed:

- (a) to drive a vehicle in any of the following lengths of road except in the direction specified in relation to that length of road:

Length of road partly in the Parish of Chudleigh and partly in the Parish of Ashcombe in the County of Devon

That length of the Teignmouth—Ashcombe Cross Road, B.3192, which extends from its existing junction with the south-bound carriageway of the Exeter — Newton Abbot road, A.380, south-eastwards for a distance of 115 yards.

Lengths of road in the Parish of Chudleigh in the County of Devon

That length of the new section of the Teignmouth—Ashcombe Cross road, B.3192 (including the section carrying the said length of road over the south-bound carriageway of road A.380) which extends from its junction with the existing section of road B.3192 to its junction with the north bound carriageway of road A.380.

That length of the classified road No. 297 which extends from its new junction with Road B.3192 immediately south of Ashcombe Cross to its junction with the main north-bound carriageway of road A.380 at Beggars Bush.

Direction

From north-west to south-east.

From south-east to north-west.

From north to south and then from east to west.
