## LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of Liverpool Traffic Regulation Orders Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Liverpool proposes to make the following Orders under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

### 1. (Various Roads—Speke Housing Estate) (Weight Restriction) Order

To prohibit any vehicle, the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 2 tons, from proceeding in any of the roads in the Speke Housing Estate bounded by Clough Road, Alderfield Drive, Hale Drive, Hale Road, Speke Hall Road, Dymchurch Road and Rycot Road and specified in Schedule I to this notice between the hours of 8 p.m. on any day and 7 a.m. on the following day, and also between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays, unless the vehicle is being used:

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises in or adjacent to the said roads:
- (b) in connection with any building works or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, refuse collection, the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of the said roads, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;
- (c) for agricultural or wood felling purposes;
- (d) in the course of military training operations;
- (e) by the emergency services; and
- (f) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
