2. (Pilch Lane) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order

- 1. To revoke the City Council of Liverpool (Pilch Lane and Page Moss Lane) (No Waiting) (Variation) Order, 1966 in so far as it relates to Pilch Lane and Page Moss Lane.
- 2. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by
 - (a) at any time in the length of road or on any of the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;

(b) between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in either of the lengths of roads or on the side of length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice; and

(c) for longer than 1 hour in any period of 2 hours between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on the south side of Pilch Lane from a point 15 metres (49 feet) west of its junction with Childwall Lane to a point 55 metres (181 feet) west of that junction.

3. (Mulberry Street) (One-Way Traffic and Prohibition of Waiting) Order

- 1. To revoke the City Council of Liverpool (Oxford Street/Abercromby Square) (Waiting Restrictions) Order, 1969, in so far as it relates to the east side of Mulberry Street from its junction with Oxford Street to a point 50 feet from that junction.
- 2. To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in Mulberry Street from its junction with Oxford Street to its junction with Myrtle Street otherwise than in a southerly direction.
- 3. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles at any time on the east side of Mulberry Street from its junction with Oxford Street to its junction with Cambridge Street.

4. (Hillfoot Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles at any time in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 to this notice.

5. (Binns Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order

- 1. To revoke the City Council of Liverpool (Binns Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1969, and the City Council of Liverpool (Milton Road/Dryden Road, etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1969, in so far as they relate to Binns Road.
- 2. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by véhicles between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive of any of the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 5 to this notice.

6. (Smithdown Road/Lodge Lane Area) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restrictions on Driving) Order

- 1. To revoke the City Council of Liverpool (Smithdown Road, etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1970, in so far as it relates to any of the roads specified in Schedule 6 to this notice.
- 2. To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in any of the roads or the length of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 7 to this notice otherwise than in the direction specified in relation to those roads or length of road in column 2 of the said Schedule.
- 3. To prohibit any vehicle from entering or leaving either of the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 8 to this notice at the junction specified in relation to those roads in column 2 of the said Schedule.
- 4. To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in Newstead Road from a point 15 metres (49 feet) south of its junction with River Avon Street for a distance of 3 metres (10 feet).
- 5. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles at any time in any of the lengths of roads or on any of the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 9 to this notice.

7. (Baker Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles at any time in either of the lengths of roads or on any of the sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 10 to this notice.

8. (Dartington Road) (Prohibition of Driving) Order To prohibit any vehicle from entering or leaving Dartington Road at its junction with Score Lane.

- 9. (Vineyard Street/Speke Road, etc.) (Width Restriction) Order .
- 1. To revoke the City Council of Liverpool (Meredith Street/Wharfedale Street/Burnsall Street) (Width Restriction) Order, 1973.
- 2. To prohibit any vehicle, the width of which, inclusive of any load, exceeds 6 feet, from entering:

(i) Vineyard Street, at its junction with Speke Road; (ii) Speke Road service road, at its junction with Speke

Road opposite Meredith Street; and
(iii) Speke Road service road, at its junction with Speke
Road opposite Banks Road, unless the vehicle is being

(a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or mer-chandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said roads;

(b) in connection with any building works or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, refuse struction of the said roads, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878; collection, the maintenance, improvement or recon-

(c) by the emergency services; and(d) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

The exceptions referred to will enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary (a) for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, (b) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, (c) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or contract the services therein. water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads, or sides of lengths of roads, and (d) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.
