ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of Liverpool Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that on 15th June 1973 the City Council of Liverpool made the following Orders under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968. The Orders numbered 1, 2, and 3 will become operative on the 2nd July, 1973 and the Order numbered 4 will become operative on the 6th August, 1973.

1. *(Prescot Road|Holly Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1973.*

1. To revoke the Orders specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice to the extent specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

2. *(Taylor Street Area) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1973.*

To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

3. *(Rainford Square) (One Way Traffic) Order, 1973.*

1. To revoke the City Council of Liverpool (Traffic Regulation) Order 1973 No. 2 (One Way Traffic) insofar as it relates to Rainford Square.
2. To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in Rainford Square otherwise than in a northerly direction.

4. *(Kensington Fields—Hall Lane Area) (Restrictions on Driving and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1973.*

1. To revoke the City Council of Liverpool (Hall Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1969.
2. To prohibit:—
 - (a) any vehicle from proceeding in any of the lengths of Connaught Road specified in column 1 of Schedule 4 to this notice otherwise than in the direction specified opposite such lengths of road in column 2 of the said Schedule.
 - (b) any vehicle from entering or leaving:—
Guelph Street, Edinburgh Road, Renfrew Street, Teck Street and Battenberg Street in the City of Liverpool at their respective junctions with Hall Lane.
 - (c) any vehicle proceeding in any of the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 5 to this notice in the direction specified in relation to those lengths of road in column 2 of the said Schedule from making other than a right hand turn on reaching the junction specified in relation to those lengths of road in column 3 of the said Schedule.
 - (d) with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles at any time in any of the lengths of road or sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 6 to this notice.

The exceptions referred to will enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary (a) for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, (b) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, (c) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road, or sides of lengths of road, and (d) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, provided that no vehicle (other than a vehicle being used for the purposes of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953) shall so wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m., and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 7 to this Notice.
