Notice is hereby given that the Bournemouth County Borough Council propose to make the above-named Orders under the appropriate provisions of sections 1 (1), (2) and (3), 31 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When Order "(a) to (f)" come into operation you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle on the sections of road detailed below at the times indicated:

- (a) *Cleveland Road*, between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on the eastern side between Windham Road and Spring Road.  
(b) *Dean Park Road*  
(i) at any time both sides of the south-western section whole length;  
(ii) the restriction applying between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. will be revoked on a section of the western side of the road.  
(c) *Hawkwood Road*  
(i) at any time on sections of both sides of the road at its junctions with Sea Road, Crabton Close Road and Heathcote Road;  
(ii) between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on a section of both sides of the road between Sea Road and Heathcote Road.  
(d) *Heathcote Road*, at any time from 30 feet south of Hawkwood Road to Christchurch Road.  
(e) *Junction Road*  
(i) at any time on sections of both sides at its junction with Cardigan Road and Wycliffe Road;  
(ii) between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive on a section of the eastern side;  
(iii) between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive for longer than 1 hour in any 2 hours on a section of the western side.  
(f) *Richmond Gardens*, at any time whole length of the eastern side of the southern leg.

Exceptions will permit loading and unloading and certain works.

When Order "(g)" comes into operation:

- (a) a further street parking place will be established in Dean Park Road;  
(b) a street parking place in Heathcote Road will be revoked;

- (c) a street parking place in Richmond Gardens will be revoked.

When Order "(h)" comes into operation vehicles, the unladen weight of which exceeds 30 hundredweight, will not be permitted to use King's Park Drive between Ashley Road and the main drive. Exceptions will allow access for loading and unloading and certain works.

#### BURY ST. EDMUNDS BOROUGH COUNCIL

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967, AS AMENDED  
*The Borough of Bury St. Edmunds (Parking Place and Controlled Parking Zone—Angel Hill) Order 1967 (Variation) Order 1973*

Notice is hereby given that the Bury St. Edmunds Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 35, 36, 37 and 39 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of the Order will be to extend the period of control of the Angel Hill Parking Place and Controlled Zone including all carriageways so that its use is controlled at all times instead of from 8 a.m.-6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays as at present.

However, the period within which a parking charge is payable will not be extended and will remain at 8 a.m.-6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays, and the charge will remain the same, i.e., 5p for 2 hours.

The purpose of the Order is to prevent the present indiscriminate and obstructive parking during evenings, overnight and on Sundays and to confine parking to the marked bays at all times.

The parking place will continue to be available for use for motor cars, goods vehicles with an unladen weight of not exceeding one ton and invalid carriages.

A copy of the draft Order, a map of the parking place and a copy of the statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the office of the undersigned, Room 109, Borough Offices, Angel Hill, Bury St. Edmunds, during the hours of 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Any objection to the proposal should be sent in writing to the undersigned within 21 days of the date of publication of this notice, and should state the grounds of objection.
