

BURY ST. EDMUNDS BOROUGH COUNCIL

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967, AS AMENDED

The Borough of Bury St. Edmunds (Various Street) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Restriction of Entry) (No. 2) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Bury St. Edmunds Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, to provide for traffic regulation in the undermentioned streets in Bury St. Edmunds as follows:

- (a) No waiting at any time in parts of the following roads:

Bristol Road	St. Andrew's Street (N)
Cannon Street	Springfield Road
College Street	Spring Lane
Eyre Close	Stamford Court
Hardwick Lane	Shops Road
Home Farm Lane	Station Hill
Horninger Road	Tayfen Road
Ipswich Street	Un-named road from North-
Northgate Street	gate Street/Tayfen Road
Out Northgate	roundabout to Bypass
Out Westgate	Wilks Road.

- (b) No waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in Schoolhall Lane.

- (c) Limited waiting—1 hour in 4 hours—8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays, in parts of Northgate Street and Tayfen Road.

- (d) No entry into Shakers Lane from Mount Road or Eastgate Street except for access to premises or land fronting that street.

Exceptions to the waiting restrictions referred to in (a), (b) and (c) above will permit waiting for the following purposes:

- (i) picking up or setting down passengers;
- (ii) loading or unloading goods;
- (iii) delivery and collection of postal packets;
- (iv) carrying out essential services connected with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity; and
- (v) to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air.

A copy of the proposed Order and maps showing the roads to which the Order relates together with a statement of the reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Department (Room 109), Borough Offices, Angel Hill, Bury St. Edmunds, during the hours of 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m., Mondays to Fridays.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned within 21 days of the date of the publication of this notice.

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Fore Street, Saltash) (Experimental Restrictions on Waiting) (Extension No. 2) Order 1973.

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th July 1973, the Cornwall County Council by Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, have directed that The County of Cornwall (Fore Street, Saltash) (Experimental Restrictions on Waiting) Order 1972, shall continue in force until the 20th January 1974.

The effect of the Order is:

- (i) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in either of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto;

- (ii) to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle (other than an invalid carriage or the vehicle of a disabled person) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in either of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto for a longer period than 1 hour in any 4 hours; and

- (iii) to suspend The County of Cornwall (Saltash) (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1968, insofar as it conflicts with the foregoing.

B

Exceptions are provided in the Order to allow a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to allow a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable postal packets to be delivered or collected; in connection with statutory powers or duties, building operations, the maintenance or improvement of the lengths of road or of the services therein; to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage and in connection with a funeral.

Copies of the Orders, together with a map showing the lengths of road referred to therein, will be available for public inspection during normal office hours at the County Hall, Truro, and at the Town Clerk's Office, Church House, Saltash.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date first mentioned above, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Fore Street (B.3271) in the Borough of Saltash

- (a) northern side—from a point opposite its junction with Culver Road for a distance of 158 yards in a westerly direction;

- (b) southern side—

- (i) between points 10 yards west and 10 yards east of its junction with Wesley Road; and

- (ii) between points 10 yards west and 10 yards east of its junction with Culver Road.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Fore Street (B.3271) in the Borough of Saltash

southern side—

- (a) between points 10 yards west of its junction with Culver Road and 10 yards east of its junction with Wesley Road;

- (b) from a point 10 yards west of its junction with Wesley Road for a distance of 25 yards in a westerly direction.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Various Streets, South Molton) (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that on 20th July 1973, the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, varying and extending traffic restrictions at South Molton.

When the Order comes into effect on 27th July 1973, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle:

- (i) at any time in specified lengths of Broad Street, Broad Street (section west of Post Office), Duke Street and South Street, South Molton;

- (ii) between 8 a.m.-6 p.m. daily in specified lengths of South Street, South Molton;

- (iii) for a longer period than 1 hour (in any 2 hours) between 8 a.m.-6 p.m., Monday-Saturday, in specified lengths of Broad Street (section west of Post Office) and South Street, South Molton.

The restriction in (iii) above will not apply to vehicles displaying an authorised disabled person's badge issued by a local authority.

Exceptions to the proposed restrictions will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;
- (c) taking in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage;

and, where necessary, in connection with:

- (d) the maintenance of the road; and
- (e) the supply of gas, electricity and water.
