

EASTBOURNE COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Eastbourne (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting by Heavy Vehicles) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Eastbourne County Borough Council proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle of the type specified in the Schedule to this notice to wait between the hours of 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. in any road within the County Borough.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the following purposes:

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, of the side of road or of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said road, the said side of road or any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
- (e) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said road, the said side of road or any of the said lengths of road.

(Prohibition of Cycling) No. 2 Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Fareham propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the riding of cycles along the public footpaths and lengths of public footpaths (a) between Fleet End Road and Hook Park Road, Warsash, (b) between Brook Lane and Greenaway Lane, Warsash, and (c) adjoining the south-western and south-eastern boundaries of No. 14 Ambledeale, Sarisbury.

HALIFAX COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Halifax (Southgate Pedestrian Precinct) Traffic Regulation Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Halifax County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be as follows:

- (a) To prohibit driving in part of Southgate between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. weekdays. This area will be made freely available for use by pedestrians only.
- (b) To prohibit driving at all times in part of Old Cock Yard.
- (c) To make a one-way street in Southgate (during the times when driving is not prohibited).
- (d) To prohibit the left turn from King Edward Street into Southgate.
- (e) To prohibit waiting 8 a.m.-6 p.m. Monday-Saturday on lengths of Southgate.

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Lancashire County Council (Galgate-Conder Green Road Class III No. 226 Lancaster Rural District) (Width Restriction) Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Lancashire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of any motor vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle exceeds 6 feet 6 inches in that length of the Galgate-Conder Green Road, Class III No. 226 which extends from a point 600 metres (656 yards) west of its junction with trunk road A.6, Galgate to its junction with principal road A.588 at Conder Green and near Conder Bridge in the Rural District of Lancaster.

The Order will contain exemptions to allow the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any adjacent premises, for the purpose of agriculture or timber felling and in connection with any building operation or demolition and the maintenance of essential services.

A copy of the draft Order, plan and statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the offices of the Lancaster Rural District Council, 5 Dalton Square, Lancaster and at County Hall, Preston, during normal office hours until the 24th August 1973.

MIDDLETON BOROUGH COUNCIL

(Mount Road—Kirkway) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Middleton Borough Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When this Order comes into effect, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time on the following lengths of road:

- (i) Mount Road on the southerly side between its junction with Uplands and its junction with Kirkway.
- (ii) Mount Road on the northerly side from the boundary fence between properties numbered 55-57 Mount Road to its junction with Kirkway.
