City of Sheffield (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No. 6) Order, 1973

City of Sheffield (Urban Clearways) (1967) (Amendment) (No. 12) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Sheffield City Council on the 17th August 1973 made the above Orders under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effects of which are:

1. To prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait at any time in the specified lengths of Attercliffe Road, Catch Bar Lane, Leppings Lane, Leveson Street, Princess Street, Sutherland Street and Warren Street.

2. To prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in the specified length of High Street, Mosborough.

relevant section of the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of that section or of sections 84A, 84B and 84C of the Act, or any regulations made under section 84C have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within 6 weeks of the 17th August 1973, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
