TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 to 1971

The London—Canterbury—Dover Trunk Road (Lydden—Dover Diversion Side Roads) (No. 2) Order 197

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to that section of the A2 Trunk Road which will be situated between Lydden and Dover in the county of Kent, to make an Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959, which will:

(a) authorise him—

- (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (ii) to stop up highways,
- (iii) to construct new highways, and
- (iv) to provide a new means of access to premises,

all in the vicinity of Temple Ewell and Guston near the route of the above-mentioned part of the said trunk road, and

(b) provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the authority specified therefor in the Order, as from the date on which he notifies that authority that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
