In the Case of (1) above
To revoke the Urban District Council of Worsley (Off-Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order, 1973, and to limit to vehicles not exceeding 30 cwt, unladen weight and otherwise control the use of the Town Centre Car Park (i.e. the area bounded by High Street, Pembroke Street and a line formed by its projection to Campbell Way, Campbell Way and Ashton Field Drive).

In the Case of (2) above

To prohibit driving other than in a south-east to west direction along the north section of road leading from Pembroke Street which passes the entrance to the Pembroke Halls, commencing at the westerly end of the traffic island and continuing to its junction with the south section.

In the Case of (3) above

(a) To revoke the Urban District of Worsley (Various

Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1972.

(b) To prohibit waiting as under the Order named at (a).

(c) To prohibit waiting along the lengths of road described in the Schedule hereto, the prohibition covering 24 hours in each day.

The prohibition under (c) will be subject to certain exceptions to enable:

(i) boarding or alighting from a vehicle;

(ii) loading or unloading from vehicles; and (iii) use of vehicles in connection with funerals, furniture removals, building operations, demolition, removal of obstruction to traffic and maintenance of the length of road or the services therein.
