#### A PROCLAMATION

Appointing New Year's Day 1974 a Bank Holiday in England and Wales and Northern Ireland

#### ELIZABETH R

Whereas We consider it desirable that New Year's Day in the year 1974 should be a bank holiday in England and Wales and Northern Ireland:

We, therefore, in pursuance of section 1 (3) of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, do hereby appoint New Year's Day in the year 1974 to be, in England and Wales and Northern Ireland, a bank holiday under the said Act.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace this twentyfourth day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three, and in the twenty-second year of Our Reign.

#### PASTORAL MEASURE 1968

Notice is hereby given that Her Majesty was pleased on the 24th October 1973 by Order in Council to confirm a Scheme made by the Church Commissioners providing for the demolition of the redundant church of St. Peter, Aubourn, a chapel of ease in the parish of Aubourn with Haddington, in the diocese of Lincoln, with the exception of the tower, and the appropriation of the tower together with the site of the demolished part of the church to use as a clock tower and monument and to purposes ancillary thereto, and authorising the lease of the tower and land for such use.
