WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant Wages Council

The Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant Wages Council hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Secretary of State for Employment proposals for:

(1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration and holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant) Order 1972 (Order L.R. (44)) as amended by the Wages Regulation (Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant) Order 1973 (Order L.R. (46)); and

(2) the revocation of Order L.R. (44) and Order L.R. (46).

Particulars of the proposals, which have been approved by the Pay Board, are contained in the Wages Council's Notice L.R. (47) which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals if made to it within 21 days from 6th November 1973. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Licensed Residential Establishment and Licensed Restaurant Wages Council, 12 St. James's Square, London, SW1Y 4LL. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections and quote the number of the Wages Council's Notice of Proposals L.R. (47).

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (City and County Borough of Bath) (No. 5) Order 1972 (Variation) Order 1973" varying "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (City and County Borough of Bath) (No. 5) Order 1972" by deleting therefrom the exception given in sub-paragraph (c) of Schedule 2 for the use of that length of Claremont Buildings described in Schedule 1 by vehicles of any description using the highway for the purpose of gaining access to or egress from premises in Claremont Buildings, Mezellion Place and Evelyn Terrace when snow or ice makes the use of the carriageway of Queenswood Avenue hazardous for the said purpose, and which was the subject of a local inquiry.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Secretary of State, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB (quoting TTP 44/136/05) and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Town Clerk's Office, Guildhall, Bath.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 6th November 1973, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
