#### HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 to 1971

##### *The London—Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (Colchester Northern By-Pass Side Roads) (Variation No. 2) Order 1971*

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road in the Borough of Colchester in the County of Essex, to make under sections 9 and 286 of the Highways Act 1959, an Order which will authorise him:

- (1) to revoke the London—Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (Colchester Northern By-Pass Side Roads) Order 1971 so far as that Order related to the stopping up of part of Footpath No. 33 (Colchester) and the provision of a new length of footpath in connection with the said stopping-up, and
- (2) to stop up part of footpath No. 33 (Colchester) where it crosses the new trunk road, and to construct a new length of footpath in connection with the said stopping up,
- (3) to provide for the transfer of the said new length of footpath to the Council of the Borough of Colchester as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new footpath has been completed and is open for through pedestrian traffic.

### THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968-1973

#### *Republic of Ireland: Official Certificate*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations 1968-1973 he hereby recognises the Official Certificate of the designs shown in the First Schedule hereto for the importation from Republic of Ireland of poultry meat as showing:
