The Brighton Corporation (Moulsecoomb Way/Hodshrove Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th November 1973, the Brighton County Borough Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to:

- (a) prohibit waiting at all times in Hodshrove Road from Moulsecoomb Way for 232 feet measured along the south-eastern side and for 180 feet measured along the north-western side; and
- (b) prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Fridays in Moulsecoomb Way from Lewes Road to Hodshrove Road on the south side.

The Order contains the usual provisions permitting vehicles to wait for persons to board or alight or goods to be loaded or unloaded or, if it is a Post Office vehicle for delivering or collecting postal packets; to enable the vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the roads or the services therein, or in connection with

bill posting, window cleaning or chimney sweeping.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on the 19th November 1973, and a map showing the roads may be inspected at the Enquiry Office at the Town Hall, Brighton, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays

and between 9 a.m. and noon on Saturdays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 6th November 1973, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The City and County of Bristol (High Kingsdown Area) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions) Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City and County of Bristol propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be, with certain exceptions:

(1) to prevent any vehicles waiting:
(a) in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 hereunder;

(b) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 hereunder; and
