QUEEN'S COMMENDATION FOR BRAVE CONDUCT

24021015 Corporal (Lance Sergeant) Terence Mann, Grenadier Guards

On 11th June 1973 a Company of the 1st Battalion Grenadier Guards was preparing to take part in an exercise on a Training Area in Canada. L/Sgt. Mann was the non-commissioned officer in charge of the Platoon ordered to clear up part of a range, which had been used during the preceding night for a night defensive shoot prior to the exercise. During this clearing operation a blind 66mm rocket evaluated hadly injuring fourteen Guardsmen. rocket exploded, badly injuring fourteen Guardsmen.

L/Sgt. Mann's wounds were severe and he was losing much blood from his legs, where large areas had been blown away. With no thought to his own predicament or blown away. With no thought to his own predicancial or concern about the consequences, he proceeded to pull him self on his elbows around all the casualties to give what assistance he could. In considerable pain and with great courage he shrugged off all medical assistance until he was satisfied that every casualty was being looked after by the medical team that arrived soon after the accident. The condition of his wounded comrades was all that he was concerned about. Throughout the period he remained cheefful calm and responsible. cheerful, calm and responsible.

His courage and selfless consideration for others in an unpleasant accident are worthy of the highest praise.
