# Explanatory Notes not forming part of the Notice

- Note 1. The parking places will be open at all hours and on all days of the week but the charges set out in the above Schedule will apply only between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
- NOTE 2. A standard charge of £1 will be payable if a valid ticket is not displayed on a vehicle as required.

NOTE 3. No season tickets will be issued.

Note 4. The following vehicles will be exempted from a charge:—

(a) invalid carriages

- (b) vehicles issued to disabled drivers by the Department of Health and Social Security.
  (c) vehicles left by drivers who have been issued with a notice of exemption by the Council on account of their severe disability.
- (d) vehicles displaying a badge issued under section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948.
  (e) vehicles displaying badges issued under section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 by any local authority. (488)

### GOSPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Gosport (Grange Crescent/Park Close Accessway) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1973

# HALTEMPRICE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Haltemprice Urban District (Hull Road/Buttfield Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that on 1st November 1973 the Haltemprice Urban District Council made an Order under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

This Order will come into operation on 3rd December 1973 and will restrict waiting by vehicles in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto for a longer period than and except as provided in column 2 of the said Schedule.

(d) to enable building or engineering works to be carried out in or near the said lengths of road.
(e) to enable furniture to be removed from and to adjoining premises.
(f) to waive on the direction of a police officer in uniform.
