

point approximately 300 feet south-east of King's Barn Farm, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 1,990 feet, thence north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 70 feet, thence southwards for a distance of approximately 530 feet to its junction with Kent Street.

(23) extinguish the public footpath (Path No. 1790), in the Parishes of Cowfold and Shermanbury, commencing at its junction with Kent Street Lane at a point approximately 480 feet west of Westridge Farm extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 3,100 feet to its junction with Wineham Lane.

(24) divert part of the public bridleway (Path No. 2832), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at a point approximately 320 feet south-east of its junction with the Lower Beeding-Handcross Road (A.279), near Dockers Lodge, extending generally south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 1,050 feet, and substituting for that path a new length of public bridleway, a minimum width of 9 feet, commencing at the north-western end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 750 feet, thence eastwards for a distance of approximately 390 feet, thence generally north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 180 feet, to rejoin the original route at the south-eastern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(25) divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 1724), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at a point approximately 420 feet east of its junction with the A.279 road, north-east of Stablehouse Cottages, extending eastwards for a distance of approximately 400 feet thence generally north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 500 feet to Eastland Hill, and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at the south-western end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending generally north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 840 feet, to join the north-eastern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(26) extinguish the public footpath (Path No. 1803), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, commencing at its junction with Burnthouse Lane at a point approximately 330 feet south of Twisted Cottage, extending generally eastwards for 2,430 feet to its junction with the public bridleway (Path No. 1726), at Jogscastle Gill.

(27) divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 1721), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with Newells Lane, south of Newells Farm, extending north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 260 feet and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet commencing at Newells Lane, at a point approximately 290 feet north of the south-western end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 160 feet to rejoin the original route at the north-eastern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(28) extinguish the public footpath (Path No. 3206), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, commencing at its junction with Grouse Road at a point approximately 550 feet north-east of Forest Lodge, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 670 feet thence south-westwards for a distance of approximately 100 feet, thence south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 1,680 feet, thence south-westwards for a distance of approximately 940 feet to its junction with the public bridleway (Path No. 2794).

(29) divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 1708), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the Lower Beeding-Handcross Road (A.279), commencing at a point approximately 650 feet north-east of The Quest, extending northwards for a distance of approximately 1,120 feet, thence north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 730 feet, and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at the southern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending northwards, east of the existing path, for a distance of approximately 1,120 feet, thence north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 730 feet, to join the northern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(30) divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 1708) in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the Hammerpond Road at a point approximately 360 feet east of Jackson's Farm, extending southwards for a distance of approximately 160 feet then southwestwards for a distance of approximately 1,300 feet, and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at the

northern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending southwards for a distance of approximately 160 feet, thence eastwards for a distance of approximately 100 feet, thence south-westwards for a distance of approximately 1,320 feet, thence westwards for a distance of approximately 80 feet, to rejoin the original route at the southern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(31) extinguish part of the public footpath (Path No. 1698/1), in the Parish of Lower Beeding commencing at its junction with public bridleway (Path No. 2822), in St. Leonard's Forest, extending north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 300 feet to its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 2814), at a point approximately 490 feet west of Springfield Cottage.

(32) divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 1702) in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with Hammerpond Road at a point approximately 400 feet east of Jackson's Farm extending northwards for a distance of approximately 140 feet, and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at the Hammerpond Road at a point approximately 80 feet east of the southern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending north-westwards for a distance of approximately 160 feet to rejoin the original route at the northern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(33) extinguish part of the public footpath (Path No. 1698), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, commencing at its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 1698/1) at Four Beeches in St. Leonard's Forest, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 900 feet to its junction with the public bridleway (Path No. 2822), near the Ranger's Lodge.

(34) divert part of the public bridleway (Path No. 1546), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at a point approximately 160 feet south-east of Cottesmore School, at Buchan Hill, extending northwards for a distance of approximately 500 feet, and substituting for that path a new length of public bridleway, a minimum width of 9 feet, commencing at the southern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 210 feet, thence north-westwards for a distance of approximately 350 feet to rejoin the original route at the northern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(35) divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 1559), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at a point approximately 140 feet east of the Lower Beeding-Rusper Parish boundary, at Burnt Stubbs, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 310 feet, and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at the north-western end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending eastwards for a distance of approximately 310 feet, thence southwards for a distance of approximately 90 feet, to rejoin the original route at the south-eastern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(36) extinguish the public footpath (Path No. 1561/1), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, commencing at its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 1561), south of Kilnwood Cottage, extending westwards for a distance of approximately 25 feet, thence southwards for a distance of approximately 280 feet, to its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 1561).

(37) divert part of the public bridleway (Path No. 1550), in the Parish of Lower Beeding by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the railway line at a point approximately 300 feet north-west of Mill Farm, extending north-westwards for a distance of approximately 770 feet, thence westwards for a distance of approximately 190 feet, thence north-westwards for a distance of approximately 80 feet, and substituting for that path a new length of public bridleway, a minimum width of 9 feet, commencing at the south-eastern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending northwards for a distance of approximately 200 feet, thence north-westwards for a distance of approximately 740 feet, thence westwards for a distance of approximately 200 feet, to join the north-western end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.

(38) divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 1561), in the Parish of Lower Beeding, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the public bridleway (Path No. 1550), at Kilnwood Copse, extending generally south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 730 feet, thence south-westwards for a distance of approximately 160 feet,
