PAY—RATINGS, ROYAL NAVY AND OTHER RANKS, ROYAL MARINES

1. *Seaman and Other Branches*

(a) Pay classification in this paragraph shall be in accordance with the scale designation in the last column below:

	Adults after 26 weeks who have completed Part I new entry training and ex-Juniors who have completed 26 weeks' service.	A
Able Rating	Not passed for Leading Rating, also Seamen with no Specialist Qualifications or Star Specialist Qualifications.	C
	After one year's service in the rating	B
	Passed for Leading Rating (Seamen must hold Star SQ)	A
	Seamen with 2nd Class SQ whether or not passed for Leading Rating

NOTES:

(i) Acting Leading Ratings (except Acting Leading Seamen with 1st Class or Instructor SQ's) and all Acting Petty Officers are to be paid Scale B Pay. Local Acting PO's and CPO's are not eligible for the award of Scale A Pay.

(ii) Chief Petty Officers and Petty Officers may only receive Scale A Pay after satisfying the time qualification in the rating and with the Commanding Officer's recommendation—whether or not holding an Instructor SQ or serving in the Communications Branch. The requirement for three years as a Petty Officer may include up to one year's Acting time.

(iii) The references to Specialist Qualifications in the Pay Classification are for Seaman Branch ratings only e.g. Naval Airmen are not governed by these provisions.

(b) *Daily Rates of Pay.* Seaman and Other Branches.
