LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930 WATER RESOURCES ACT 1963

Lincolnshire River Authority

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4 (3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963, has now made an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Lincolnshire River Authority for the transfer to the River Authority of all such rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities (including liabilities incurred in connection with works) over or in connection with the main river of the River Authority Area as were immediately before the date of submission of the Scheme vested in or to be discharged by various drainage authorities and any property held by those authorities for the purpose of, or in connection with, any functions so transferred.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the Land Drainage Act 1930, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

Over and Willingham Internal Drainage District

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4(3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Great Ouse River Authority, under section 4(1)(b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, making provision for:

- (i) the abolition of the Over Internal Drainage District and the Drainage Board thereof and of the Willingham Fen District and the Commissioners for the drainage of Willingham Fen;
- (ii) the constitution of the Over and Willingham Internal Drainage District and of the Over and Willingham Internal Drainage Board;
- (iii) matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

The Scheme affects lands in the Parishes of Over, Swavesey, and Willingham in the Rural District of Chesterton in the County of Cambridgeshire and Isle of Ely.

The Scheme may affect the liability to drainage rates of properties in the areas mentioned above.
