##### *The Trunk Road (Wrexham) (Bus Stops) (Clearway) Order 1974*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

The purpose of the Order is to prohibit vehicles, other than buses from waiting between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day at any bus stop in the length of road specified below where the carriageway at that stop is marked (a) as a bus stop, and (b) with a broad yellow line adjacent to the edge of the carriageway ("the authorised markings").

Although the Order includes every bus stop in the length of road specified below, it should be noted that the provisions of the Order which prohibit waiting only apply to those bus stops which the Secretary of State has marked with the authorised markings.

While the Order remains in force it enables the Secretary of State at any time to lay or remove the authorised markings at or from any bus stop in the specified length of road or to adjust the position in that length of road of the authorised markings, as traffic conditions may require.

Other vehicles are permitted to wait at the bus stops with authorised marking where necessary for:

1. The removal of an obstruction to traffic.
2. The maintenance of the road, and in exercise of statutory powers with permission of the local authority; and
3. Reasons of emergency.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks of the 30th January 1974 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
