- (3) The London—Penzance Trunk Road (Ilchester By-Pass) Compulsory Purchase Order (No. CSW 197), notice of which was published on 11th January 1974.

This Order is an Order under sections 214 and 215 of the Highways Act 1959 and section 44 of the Highways Act 1971 and under section 1 of the Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure) Act 1946 which, if made, will authorise the Secretary of State to purchase compulsorily the land described therein for the purpose of the improvement of the London—Penzance Trunk Road (A303) at or near to Ilchester in the County of Somerset and for the purpose of the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in the said County in pursuance of the above-mentioned Orders under sections 7 and 9 of the Highways Act 1959.

Proceedings on the above-mentioned draft Orders are being taken concurrently by virtue of section 53 of the Highways Act 1971.

The Secretary of State hereby directs that any person who intends at the Inquiries to submit that any highway or proposed highway to which the draft Orders or either of them relate should follow an alternative route, or that, instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway to which the draft Orders or either of them relate, a new highway should be constructed on a particular route, shall send to him at the South Western Road Construction Unit not later than Tuesday, 12th March 1974 sufficient information about the alternative route or the route of the new highway, as the case may be, to enable it to be identified. Failure to comply with this direction will entitle the Secretary of State and the person holding the Inquiries to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.
