NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Comprising an area of 615 acres or thereabouts situated to the south-east of the Sunderland No. 6 Smoke Control Alexandra Road from Silksworth Lane to Tunstall Road; on the east in part by Tunstall Road and Tunstall Hope Road from Queen Alexandra Road to the disused mineral railway line; on the south by the disused mineral railway line from Tunstall Hope Road to Durham Terrace and by Silksworth Lane from Durham Terrace to North Moor Road; on the west by the easternmost boundary of the Sunderland No. 6 Smoke Control Area and the southernmost boundary of the Sunderland No. 11 Smoke Control Area which area is more particularly defined and coloured green on the Planning Officers Drawing No. RT/11/10, but exempting from the operation of the said section 11 all those fireplaces in buildings, or parts of buildings separately occupied, without gas supply, on the condition that only authorised fuels, as declared by Regulations made under the Clean Air Acts, and kindling sticks and paper shall be used in the fireplaces, as referred to in the Schedule to the Order.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

SUNDERLAND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

THE CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

The Sunderland (No. 13) Smoke Control Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Sunderland County Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 19th day of December 1973, made an Order entitled "the Sunderland (No. 13) Smoke Control Order 1973", declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless
