ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BURNLEY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Burnley (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1974

Notice is hereby given that the Burnley County Borough Council proposes to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and section 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be as shown in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of roads to which the Order relates may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Burnley, during normal office hours.

Objections to the Order, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be made in writing to the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Burnley, by Tuesday, 5th March 1974.

THE SCHEDULE

(a) *Waiting prohibited at all times on lengths of the following highways.*

Bancroft Road, Barden Street, Belvedere Road, Branch Road, Briercliffe Road, Brunshaw Road, Brunshaw Avenue, Brownhill Avenue, Brooklands Road, Casterton Avenue, Colne Road, Crow Nest, Eastern Avenue, Healey Wood Road, Hollingreave Road, Hufing Lane, Langham Street, Lindsay Street, Oxford Road, Owen Street, Parker Lane, Plumbe Street, Scott Park Road, St. Matthew Street, Stroyan Street, Temple Street, Todmorden Road and Widow Hill Road.

(b) *No waiting between 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.—otherwise no restrictions any day, on lengths of the following highways.*

Plumbe Street and Temple Street.

(c) *No waiting between 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday—otherwise no restrictions on lengths of the following highways.*

Brunshaw Avenue, Elm Street, Lyndhurst Road, New Hall Street, Newman Street, Old Hall Street, Stroyan Street.

(d) *No waiting between 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturdays and 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. on Tuesdays—otherwise no restrictions on lengths of the following highways.*

Admiral Street, Albert Street, Belvedere Road, Brandwood Grove, Brownhill Avenue, Browsholme Avenue, Carholme Avenue, Chichester Close, Holmsley Street, Holcombe Drive, Leyland Road, Linden Street, Mitella Street, Mizpah Street, Ormerod Road, Ridge Road, Thursfield Road, Thurston Street.

(e) *Prohibiting loading and unloading between 8 a.m. to 9 a.m., 12 noon to 1.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6 p.m.*

Westerley side of Todmorden Road for 25 metres on either side of Rock Lane.

(f) *Revocation of waiting restrictions*

Waiting between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in Plumbe Street on both sides from its junction with Parliament Street in a westerly direction
