## WAGES COUNCIL

### WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

#### *Retail Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (England and Wales)*

The Retail Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (England and Wales) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Secretary of State for Employment proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Retail Bespoke Tailoring) (England and Wales) Order 1973 (Order R.B.(79)); (2) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Retail Bespoke Tailoring) (England and Wales) (Holidays) Order 1973 (Order R.B.(80)); and (3) the revocation of Order R.B.(79) and Order R.B.(80).

Particulars of the proposals, which have been approved by the Pay Board, are contained in the Wages Council's Notice R.B.(81) which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals if

made to it within 14 days from 1st March 1974. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Retail Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (England and Wales), 12 St. James's Square, London, SW1Y 4LL. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections and quote the number of the Wages Council's Notice of Proposals R.B.(81).

## DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-Up of Highways (County of Lancaster) (No. 6) Order 1974", authorising the stopping-up of a length of Holden Street and Swindells Street, Ashton-under-Lyne, Lancashire.

Copies of the Order may be obtained free of charge, on application to the Department of the Environment at the office of the Regional Controller (Roads and Transportation), North West Region, Sunley Building, Piccadilly Plaza, Manchester, M1 4BE (quoting DNW 30035/1/027) and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Town Hall, Ashton-under-Lyne.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 1st March 1974, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that on the application of the Saddleworth Urban District Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on lengths of Platt Street, Atherton Street, John Booth Street, Greenwood Street and an unnamed highway lying between John Booth Street and Woodend Street at Saddleworth.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) on behalf of a statutory undertaker or the Post Office and engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal under, in, on, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway, of any main, pipe, conduit, wire cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (c) a vehicle being used by the local highway authority in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties.

During 28 days from the 1st March 1974, copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at the Council Offices, St. Chads, Uppermill, Oldham, OL3 6AS, and may be obtained free of charge from the Secretary of State (quoting DYH 300/41/7/013) at the address stated below.

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days, any person may by notice to the Secretary of State (Ref. DYH 300/41/7/013), at his address at the office of the Regional Controller (Roads and Transportation), Yorkshire and Humberside Region, 6th Floor, City House, Leeds, LS1 4JD, object to the making of the Order.
