- (3) It is desired to disclaim the Crown's title (if any) to the property.
- (4) That the property may have vested came to the notice of the Treasury Solicitor on the 10th December 1973.

Now therefore I, the Treasury Solicitor, in exercise of the power in that behalf given by section 355 of the Companies Act 1948, do by this notice disclaim the Crown's title (if any) to the property described in the Schedule hereto.

The London—Fishguard Trunk Road (Morfa Lane, Carmarthen, De-Trunking) Order 197

The Cardiff—Llangurig Trunk Road A.470 (Gray's Place, Merthyr Vale, Side Roads) Order 197

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has appointed Mr. J. H. Seddon, B.Sc., M.I.C.E., M.I.H.E., to hold a Public Local Inquiry commencing at 10.30 a.m. on Tuesday, 23rd April 1974, at the Clarence Hall, Crickhowell, in connection with the above-mentioned Orders.

The first said Order would, if made, authorise the Secretary of State:

- (i) to construct a new trunk road, slip roads and trunk road connections with the existing road system;
- (ii) to de-trunk certain superseded lengths of trunk road.

The second said Order would, if made, authorise the Secretary of State:

- (i) (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (b) to stop up highways,
- (c) to construct new highways,
- (d) to provide new private means of access to premises

all in the vicinity of the above-mentioned roads:

- (ii) to provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Powys or Gwent as appropriate as from 1st April next after the date on which the Secretary of State notifies that authority that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
