

HOUNSLOW LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The London Borough of Hounslow (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1974*

Notice is hereby given that on the 11th March 1974 the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow made an Order under sections 31 and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (as amended) the effect of which is to create off-street parking places on the areas of land specified by name in column 1 of Schedules I and II to this Notice and to revoke the existing Byelaws relating to parking places specified in Schedule III to this Notice. The Order will come into operation on the 25th March 1974.

The positions in which vehicles may be left in parking places, the classes of vehicle permitted in the parking places, the days of operation and the hours during which the parking places shall be closed are as specified in the said Schedules I and II. No charges will be made in respect of the said parking places.

A copy of the Order and copies of the Byelaws specified in the said Schedule III may be inspected at the Town Hall, Treaty Road, Hounslow, Middlesex during normal office hours until the 26th April 1974.
