The effect of this Order which will come into operation on 7th April 1974, will be that no one will be permitted to drive a vehicle along the various streets specified in the Schedule to this notice except in the direction specified in the said Schedule.

OLDHAM COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Oldham (Disabled Persons Relaxation of Waiting Restrictions) Order, 1974

Notice is hereby given that on 19th March 1974, the Oldham County Borough Council made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is to amend the Orders listed in the Schedule to the Order to allow disabled persons vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by any local authority to wait on the sides of the lengths of road specified in the said Orders except in the case of the County of Oldham (Glodwick Area) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) Order, 1973, where disabled persons' vehicles shall not be allowed to wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of that Order between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. when loading and unloading is prohibited in the said lengths of road. The police and traffic wardens will retain their power to require vehicles to move if, in their opinion an obstruction is being caused.

The Order came into operation 26th March 1974, and a copy of the Order may be inspected at the Borough Secretary's Office, Town Hall, Oldham, between the hours of 8.40 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday, inclusive, until the 3rd May 1974.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers enforced by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks of the said 19th March 1974, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
