NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Devon River Authority by F. & C. Walters, Columbjohn, Rewe, Exeter for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from the River Culm at the following point of abstraction:

56,000 gallons per day with a total of 904,000 gallons per annum at any point between SS 966006 and SX 956994.

Further details of the application are: For the purpose of spray irrigation.

A copy of the application and of any map, plan or other document submitted with it may be inspected free of charge at Columbjohn, Rewe, Exeter at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 9th April 1974 and ending on 11th May 1974.

THE CLEAN AIR ACT

Thurrock Urban District Council No. 11 Smoke Control Order 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Thurrock Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 29th March 1974 made an Order entitled the "Thurrock Urban District Council No. 11 Smoke Control Order 1973" declaring the area described in the schedule hereto and more particularly coloured pink on the map forming part of the Order to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Department of the Environment for confirmation.

If on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney or any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised
