The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under section 2 of the Counter Inflation Act 1973 viz: The Counter Inflation (Price and Pay Code) (Amendment) Order 1974.

This Order amends the Counter Inflation (Price and Pay Code) (No. 2) Order 1973 by inserting in Part I of the Schedule to that Order (which relates to prices and charges) provisions dealing with the effect of changes in indirect taxes.

The Order came into operation on 5th April 1974 and has been published as Statutory Instrument 1974 No. 661.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under sections 12 (4) and 43 (1) of the Finance Act 1972 viz: The Value Added Tax (General) (No. 1) Order 1974.

This Order imposes value added tax at the standard rate on certain food products and drinks, including:

(a) Ice cream, ice lollies, frozen yoghurt, similar frozen products and preparations for making such products;
