Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Welsh National Water Development Authority, Dee and Clwyd River Division, by Captain D. F. Myddelton, of Chirk Castle Estate, Chirk, c/o Cooke, Leathes & Bickerton, 24 High Street, Mold, Flintshire, CH7 1AY, to vary licence serial No. 24/67/6/20/GS to abstract water from a spring at National Grid Reference SJ.242 398 in the parish of Glyntrain and the district of Glyndwr.
