The Preston (Area No. 29) Smoke Control Order, 1973

Notice is hereby given that the Preston County Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 19th December 1973 made an Order entitled the Preston (Area No. 29) Smoke Control Order, 1973 declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney or any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before

the 1st October 1974, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.
