Proposed Weight Restriction at Low Road and Upper Row, Dunham-on-Trent

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council have made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit the use of those lengths of road described in the Schedule to this notice by vehicles having an unladen weight in excess of three tons.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable the said roads to be used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated in or adjacent to the lengths of road; for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the lengths of road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land; in connection with any building operation or any demolition in or adjacent to that land, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the lengths of road, the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of the lengths of road, or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or adjacent to the lengths of road of any sewer of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic lines as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878; in the course of military training operations; or for the conveyance of children to or from Dunham-on-Trent Primary School.

A copy of the proposed Order, which will come into force on 17th May 1974 and a map showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected, during normal office hours at the office of the Secretary and Legal Officer, Bassetlaw District Council, Town Hall, Worksop, Notts, or at my office.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, within 6 weeks from the 17th May 1974, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Parish of Dunham-on-Trent

1. That length of Low Road (unclassified) from its junction with the Laneham—Ragnall Road (C2) in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Main Street a total distance measured along its length of 873 yards.
2. That length of Upper Row (unclassified) from its junction with the Worksop—Lincoln Road (A57) in a northerly direction to its junction with Low Road a total distance measured along its length of 470 yards.

Prohibition of Waiting at Newthorpe Common Eastwood

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council have made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting by any vehicle at any time in the length of road referred to in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle, to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878, or to enable a vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

A copy of the Order which comes into force on 17th May 1974 and a map showing the length of road affected may be inspected, during normal office hours, at the office of the Director of Administration and Legal Services,

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that the requirements of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may within 6 weeks from 17th May 1974 apply to the High Court for that purpose.

Both sides of that length of Newthorpe Common (unclassified) from its junction with the Nottingham—Eastwood Road (A.610) for a distance of 50 yards in a south-westerly direction.

Nottinghamshire County Council Restriction of Waiting at Carr Lane Warsop

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council have made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and mid-night on any day in the length of road referred to in the First Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from a vehicle, to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878, or to enable a vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
