

2. The second said Order would, if made, authorise the Secretary of State:

- (a) (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter the unclassified road C.115 at Ty'n-y-lon and Lon Refail at Llanfairpwllgwyngyll both in the county of Gwynedd,
- (ii) to stop up part of the unclassified road C.115 at Ty'n-y-lon and part of the existing London-Holyhead Trunk Road (A.5) at Llanfairpwllgwyngyll,
- (iii) to construct a new highway to connect the C.115 road at Ty'n-y-lon with the new trunk road described in paragraph 1 (a) above,
- (iv) to stop up parts of the private means of access to:
 - (i) the construction camp situated near Britannia Bridge in the Arfon District of the county of Gwynedd,
 - (ii) Treborth Railway Station and the Electricity Sub-Station situated near Ty'n-y-lon,
- (v) to provide new means of access to:
 - (i) the premises described in paragraph (a) (iv) above and
 - (ii) the properties known as Coedlys, Pant-y-eurach and Raybern situated at Llanfairpwllgwyngyll,
- (b) to provide for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Gwynedd as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

3. The third said Order would, if made, authorise the Secretary of State to purchase compulsorily the land and rights described in the Schedule thereto for the purposes of:

- (i) the construction of the new trunk roads from near Ty'n-y-lon across the Britannia Bridge as far as the A.5 Trunk Road in the vicinity of its junction with Lon Refail, Llanfairpwllgwyngyll in the Ynys Môn-Isle of Anglesey Borough and the Arfon District in the county of Gwynedd and in the Menai Straits in pursuance of the first said Order,
- (ii) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in connection with the new trunk roads in pursuance of the second said Order,
- (iii) the improvement of the London-Holyhead Trunk Road A.5 and the Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road A.487 in the said Borough and District in the said County,
- (iv) the diversions of watercourses and the execution of other works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk roads, the construction and improvement of the other highways and execution of other works mentioned in the foregoing subparagraphs,
- (v) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and such execution of other works as aforesaid.

4. The fourth said Order would, if made, authorise the Secretary of State to purchase compulsorily the land and rights described in the Schedule thereto for the purposes of:

- (i) the construction and improvement of highways in the Arfon District in the County of Gwynedd in connection with the new trunk roads in pursuance of the second said Order,
- (ii) the improvement of the Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road A.487 in the said District in the said County.

Copies of the said four draft Orders and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU, and at the offices of Gwynedd County Council, County Offices, Caernarvon, LL55 1SH; Arfon District Council, Town Hall, Bangor, LL57 2RE; Ynys Môn Borough Council, Bridge Street, Llangefni, LL77 7PN and the Public Library at Llanfairpwllgwyngyll.

The Secretary of State hereby directs pursuant to section 14 (5) of the Highways Act 1971 that any person who intends at the Inquiry to submit that any highway or proposed highway to which the said draft Orders London-Holyhead Trunk Road and Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Ty'n-y-lon to Llanfairpwllgwyngyll Diversions and Slip Roads) Order 197 and London-Holyhead Trunk Road and Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Ty'n-y-lon to Llanfairpwllgwyngyll Diversions and Slip Roads Side Roads) Order 197 relate should follow an alternative route or that instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway to which the

said draft Orders relate a new highway should be constructed on a particular route, shall send to him at the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU, not later than 9th July 1974 sufficient information about the alternative route or the route of the new highway, as the case may be, to enable it to be identified. Failure to comply with this direction will entitle the Secretary of State and the person holding the Inquiry to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.
