#### TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office at the Bank of England on Friday the 2nd August 1974, at 1 p.m. for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877, and the National Loans 'Act 1968, to the amount of £170,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000,  $\pounds$ 50,000, £50,000, £100,000, or £250,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tendered on any business day from Monday the 5th August 1974 to Friday the 9th August 1974 inclusive, and will be due 91 days after date.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000, and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated, and the net amount per cent. (being a multiple of one new half-penny) which will be given for the amounts applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.

5. Tenders must be made through a London Banker, Discount House or Broker.

6. Notification will be sent on the same day as Tenders are received to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part. Payment in full of the amounts due in respect of such accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England by means of cash or by draft or cheque drawn on the Bank of England not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated.

7. Members of the House of Commons are not precluded from tendering for these Bills.

8. Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Chief Cashier's Office, Bank of England.

9. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right of rejecting any Tenders.

1. Charges for calls are increased.

2. The distance steps for trunk calls are expressed in kilometres instead of miles.

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

#### Commencement, citation and extent

(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 12th August 1974 and may be cited as the Post Office Telephone Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1974 (Post Office Scheme T1/1974).
 (2) This Scheme shall apply and extend to the United Kingdom and the Isle of Man.

#### Interpretation

2.—(1) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Telephone Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme T3/1972) (hereinafter called "the principal Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Telephone Amendment (No. 1A) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme T1A/1973) and the Post Office Telephone Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme T7/1973).

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### Inland call charges

3. For Schedule 7 of the principal Scheme which prescribes charges for inland calls there shall be substituted the following Schedule:
