

POST OFFICE ACT 1969 SECTION 13 (2) (AS AMENDED BY THE MINISTRY OF POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS (DISSOLUTION) ORDER 1974).

Copy of an approval given on behalf of the Secretary of State for Industry on 29th August 1974.

1. Pursuant to subsection (2) of section 13 of the Post Office Act 1969, I, Stella P. M. Fisher, an officer of the Department of Industry duly authorised to act in that behalf, hereby give my approval on behalf of the Secretary of State for Industry for the purposes of that subsection to the carrying on by the Post Office of the activity specified in paragraph 2 of this approval.

2. The purchase, without financial limit, for supply only to the following body, of lubricants, spare parts, equipment and accessories for use in connection with the servicing and repair of the motor transport vehicles of that body:

Her Majesty's Prison, Aberdeen.
