- (1) Divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 1759), in the Parish of Cowfold, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 1764), extending generally westwards for a distance of approximately 970 feet to Browning's Gill, and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet commencing on the public footpath (Path No. 1764), approximately 100 feet south of the eastern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending generally north-westwards for a distance of approximately 120 feet, thence south-westwards for a distance of approximately 120 feet, to rejoin the original route at the western end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up.
