#### *The Trunk Road (Bangor Road, Conwy) (One-Way Traffic) (Experimental) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, which will come into operation on 1st April 1975, the effect of which is that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in a direction other than from south-east to north-west in that length of the trunk road which is specified in the Schedule to this notice.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks of the 6th January 1975, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

##### *Length of the Trunk Road*

That length of the Chester—Bangor Trunk Road A.55 known as Bangor Road at Conwy in the Borough of Aberconwy in the County of Gwynedd which extends from a point 40 yards south-east of its junction with Upper Gate Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 87 yards.
