## AGRICULTURAL WAGES BOARD

The Agricultural Wages Board for England and Wales hereby give notice that they propose to make an Order, that from 21st July 1975, women's rates of pay shall be increased where appropriate to 87½ per cent. of the corresponding male rates. Details of the proposed rates are shown in the Schedule to this notice.

Any objections to these proposals must be lodged with the Secretary of the Board not later than 19th May 1975. Objections should be in writing and should state precisely the grounds of objection.

## SCHEDULE

It is proposed to vary the provisions of the Agricultural Wages Board's Order numbered 1975 AWB No. 1 so that for the women's minimum weekly, hourly, overtime and night work rates payable from 21st July 1975 and set out in that Order there shall be substituted the rates set out below. Rates for workers below the age of 19 are not affected.

## AGRICULTURAL WAGES ACT 1948

## AGRICULTURAL WAGES BOARD

The Agricultural Wages Board hereby give notice that they propose to make an Order varying the special minimum rates of wages, holiday remuneration and the value at which the provision of board and lodging may be reckoned as part payment of minimum wages, in respect of the employment in agriculture of *foreign student employees admitted into England and Wales for limited periods under an approved exchange scheme*.

The Board propose, subject to the making of an Order to increase from 21st July 1975, the women's rates in the main Order to 87½ per cent. of the corresponding male rates, that the rates payable to female foreign students should be similarly adjusted where appropriate. Schedule A includes unadjusted female rates from 21st July. Schedule B shows the adjusted rates.

In addition the Board propose that the holiday provisions of the Board's 1975 AWB No. 1 Order shall apply.

Any objections to these proposals must be lodged with the Secretary of the Board not later than 19th May 1975. Objections should be in writing and should state precisely the grounds for objection.
