

BERKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Royal County of Berkshire (Wokingham-Bracknell Road (A329) (Coppid Beech Hill) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1975.

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles from proceeding on that length of the former Old London Road on the south side of Old London Road (A329) at Coppid Beech Hill for the entire length from its junction with Old London Road (A329) eastwards, past the access drive to St. Anne's Nursing Home, a distance of approximately 291 metres (318 yards) or thereabouts, except for access.

The Order shall come into force on the 5th May 1975.

Copies of the Order and relevant map can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Wokingham District Council and at the County Surveyor's Office, Road Planning and Traffic Management Section, 1st Floor, Kennet House, Kings Road, Reading.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulations Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 29th April 1975 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

BRENTWOOD DISTRICT COUNCIL

Brentwood District Council (No waiting and Limited Waiting) (Kings Road) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Brentwood District Council, acting for and on behalf of the Essex County Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972, propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to amend the period during which the existing waiting restrictions are in force in Kings Road so as to accord with the Peak Flow Clearway Order shortly to be introduced.

Exceptions will permit a vehicle to wait for the purposes of:

- (i) Picking up and setting down passengers.
- (ii) Loading or unloading goods, and, where necessary, in connection with
- (iii) The maintenance of the roads, and
- (iv) The supply of gas, electricity and water.

BRIGHTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Brighton (St. George's Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Brighton Borough Council, acting as agents for the East Sussex County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972.

When the Order comes into effect, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time in St. George's Road, other than in the two lengths of the road which are already restricted to waiting for 30 minutes in the hour.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods,

and, where necessary, in connection with:

- (c) the maintenance of the roads, and
- (d) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

The Brighton Corporation (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Order, 1972) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1975.

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(Prohibition of Driving) (Access Road) (Between 32 and 34 West Street, Marlow) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given, that Buckinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or leaving the access road between 32 and 34 West Street at its junction with the service road to the Car Park.
