

the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the following lengths of road:

- (1) Twynrobyn Road, from its junction with the Eastern By-Pass A.4102 to its junction with Penuel Street, both sides.
- (2) The road connecting Alma Street with Twynrobyn Road, both sides.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, the maintenance of essential services, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office.

The Order came into operation on the 29th April 1975, and a copy thereof and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 29th April 1975.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act as so amended or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 29th April 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
