WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain)

The Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Secretary of State for Employment proposals for (1) varying the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Rope, Twine and Net) Order 1974 (Order R.(164)) as amended by the Wages Regulation (Rope, Twine and Net) (Amendment) Order 1975 (Order R.(166)); (2) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Rope, Twine and Net) (Holidays) Order 1970 (Order R.(156)) as amended by Schedule 2 to the Wages Regulation (Rope, Twine and Net) Order 1974 (Order R.(164)); and (3) the revocation of Orders R.(164), R.(166) and R.(156). Particulars of the proposals are contained in the Wages Council's Notices R.(167) and R.(168) which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals if made to it within 14 days from 16th May 1975. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain), 12 St. James's Square, London, SW1Y 4LL. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections and quote the number of the Wages Council's Notice of Proposals R.(167) and R.(168).
