SALMON AND FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACTS 1923-72

Fishery Byelaws

Notice is hereby given that the Northumbrian Water Authority intend to apply to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, not less than one month after the date of publication of this notice, for confirmation of Byelaws made by the Authority the effect of which is as follows:

- to provide an annual close season for fishing for salmon with rod and line;
- to dispense with an annual close season for freshwater fish in certain waters;
- to prohibit the use of hand and night lines for taking or attempting to take salmon, trout or freshwater fish.

During the period of one month from the date of publication of this notice, a printed copy of the said Byelaws will be deposited at the offices of the Authority (Eldon House, Regent Centre, Gosforth, Newcastle upon Tyne 3) and will be open to public inspection, without charge, on any weekday other than Saturday during normal office hours. During the same period, printed copies of the Byelaws will be supplied on demand free of charge to any person appearing to the Authority to be interested. Any objection to the confirmation of the Byelaws should be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Fisheries Division, Branch 1B, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London, SW1P 2AE, not later than 13th June 1975. NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Thames Water Authority by A. R. and J. E. McTurk of 36 Mascalls Lane, Brentwood, Essex, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from a pond at Calcott Hall Farm, Ongar Road, Brentwood, at the following point of abstraction: 750,000 gallons per year at O.S. NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to The Yorkshire Water Authority by British Gypsum Ltd., Ferguson House, 15-17 Marylebone Road, London, NW1 5JE, to vary the licence 2/27/24/154 granted to Bellrock Gypsum Industries Limited to abstract water from the existing borehole 540 feet depth by 8 inch diameter into lower magnesian limestone at N.Gr. SE 51003435, Sherburn-in-Elmet Parish, North Yorkshire.

The variation applied for is: To increase the abstraction rate of water from 26.28 million gallons per annum to 78.84 million gallons per annum. (72,000 gallons per day to 216,000 gallons per day) from the existing borehole water
