## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

### BERKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Royal County of Berkshire (Thatcham) (Traffic Regulations) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 the effect of which is set out in the Schedule below.

The Order shall come into force on the 2nd June 1975.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 28th May 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

### SCHEDULE

To revoke the Royal County of Berkshire (Thatcham) (Traffic Regulations) Order 1968.

To prohibit any vehicle from being driven in an easterly direction on High Street from its junction with Trunk Road A.4 in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 5 metres.

To prohibit any vehicle from being driven so as to make a right hand turn on to Trunk Road A.4 from the western end of High Street.

To prohibit any vehicle from being driven in a southerly direction on the western side of the Broadway between its junction with Church Gate and its junction with High Street.

To prohibit any vehicle from being driven in a northerly and easterly direction on the eastern and southern sides of the new public convenience island in the Broadway.

To prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:

(a) Broadway (east side) from its junction with Trunk Road A.4 in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 89 metres.

(b) Broadway (east side) from its junction with Station Road in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 15 metres.

(c) Broadway (east side) between points approximately 35 metres and 71 metres north of its junction with Station Road.

(d) Broadway (north-west side) from its junction with Trunk Road A.4 in a south-westerly direction for a
