To prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for longer than 30 minutes in any hour on the following lengths of road:

- (a) High Street (south side) between points approximately 5 metres west of the junction with Church Lane and 21 metres east of the junction with Trunk Road A.4.
- (b) High Street (south side) between points approximately 5 metres east of the junction with Church Lane and the junction with Broadway.

To prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for longer than 1 hour in any 2 hours on the following lengths of road:

- (a) Broadway (east side) between points approximately 89 metres south of its junction with Trunk Road A.4 and 71 metres north of its junction with Station Road.
- (b) Broadway (east side) between points approximately 15 metres and 35 metres north of its junction with Station Road.
- (c) On the west side of the extended Broadway Green from a point approximately 7 metres north of its southern end in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 88 metres.
- (d) Broadway (west side) between points 38 metres and 65 metres south of its junction with High Street. (482)

The Brighton (Whipping Post Lane) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1975

Buckinghamshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (High Wycombe) (No. 2) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 22nd May 1975, Buckinghamshire County Council made orders under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, the effect of which is to introduce waiting restrictions in High Wycombe. The order will come into operation on the 1st June 1975.

Exemptions will be provided in the order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle, and to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with the maintenance
