2. When the Orders come into effect:

- (c) you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time in Regency Road on the north side between the disabled persons' vehicle parking place and Grenville Street.

- (a) picking up and setting down of passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;

and, where necessary, in connection with:

- (c) the maintenance of the road; and
- (d) the supply of gas, electricity and water.
