*The West Glamorgan County Council (Route B4286—Cwmaeon Road, Pantdu) (30 m.p.h. Speed Restriction) Order, 1975.*

*The West Glamorgan County Council (Horton Village, Gower) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1975*

*The West Glamorgan County Council (Church Street, Port Talbot) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order, 1975*

(d) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays in certain lengths of the following road:

Bristol Road

(e) To limit the waiting of vehicles to one hour in any two hours between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in certain lengths of the following road:
