- (2) that length of road known as Caradoc Road which extends from its junction with Caradoc Road/Maendy Way in an easterly direction for a distance of 51 yards;
 - (3) that length of road known as Maendy Way which extends from its junction with Llywelyn Road/Caradoc Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 34 yards;
 - (4) that length of the western footpath of Maendy Way which extends from a point 34 yards north-west of its junction with Caradoc Road/Llywelyn Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 65 yards;
 - (5) that length of the eastern footpath of Maendy Way which extends from a point 25 yards north-west of its junction with Caradoc Road/Llywelyn Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 25 yards;
 - (6) that length of footpath which extends from the junction of Caradoc Road and Maendy Way with Llywelyn Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 50 yards; and
 - (7) that length of the northern footpath of Caradoc Road which extends from a point 17 yards east of the centre point of its junction with Llywelyn Road/Maendy Way in an easterly direction for a distance of 47 yards.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971—
SECTION 209

SCHEDULE

(The distances are approximate)

The lengths of highway to be stopped up are at Cwmbran, in the Borough of Torfaen, in the County of Gwent. They are shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan and are:

- (1) a triangular section on the western side of that length of road known as Llywelyn Road which extends from its junction with Rees Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 42 yards;
- (2) a triangular section on the eastern side of that length of road known as Llywelyn Road which extends from its junction with Rees Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 47 yards;
- (3) that length of the southern footpath of un-named service road which extends from its junction with Llywelyn Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 11 yards;
- (4) that length of un-named service road which extends from a point 42 yards east of its junction with Llywelyn Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 14 yards; and
- (5) that length of the western footpath of the un-named service road which extends from a point 70 yards south of its junction with Caradoc Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 17 yards.
