

HASTINGS BOROUGH COUNCIL

Hastings Borough Council (Fir Tree Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Hastings Borough Council as agents for and on behalf of the East Sussex County Council, the highway authority, have made an Order the effect of which is as follows:—

You are not able (subject to the usual exceptions, including that related to disabled drivers) to park your vehicle at any time on the south side of Fir Tree Road.

The Order, which may be cited as the Hastings Borough (Fir Tree Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1975, was made on the 16th June, 1975, and will come into force on 23rd June 1975.

Full details are contained in the Order, which may be examined, together with a map showing the restrictions, at the Town Hall, Queen's Road, Hastings, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 16th June 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Ryde, Isle of Wight) (Revocation or Prohibition of Right-hand Turn) Order No. 1 1975.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the Isle of Wight, in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, proposed to make an Order the effect of which will be as follows:

- (1) To revoke the County of the Isle of Wight (Various Streets Ryde, I.W.) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order No. 2 1971.
- (2) The effect of this revocation will be to permit vehicles to turn right from West Street into Green Street.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of the Isle of Wight (A.3054, The Racecourse, and A.3021, The East Cowes Road, Newport, I.W.) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order 1975.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the Isle of Wight, in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, have made an Order the effect of which will be as follows:

To prohibit vehicles making a right turn from the A.3054, The Racecourse, at the extreme western end into the A.3021, East Cowes Road.

The Order will come into operation on Monday, 30th June 1975.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the said Order, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of section 1 of the said Act, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made

under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date hereof, apply to the High Court for the purpose.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, St. Helens) (One Way Traffic) Order No. 1 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight County Council in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police have made an Order the effect of which is as follows:

To revoke the County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, St. Helens) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1974 and to maintain the one-way traffic flow in The Diggins, St Helens from its junction with Field Lane to its junction with Upper Green Road in the direction from north to south.

The purpose of the Order is to restore two-way traffic to Field Lane, St. Helens.

The Order shall come into operation on 30th June 1975 and a copy of the Order, this notice and relevant plan may be inspected during normal office hours at Room 309B, County Hall, Newport, Isle of Wight.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the said Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of section 1 of the said Act, as amended or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of the date hereof apply to the High Court for the purpose.

KENT COUNTY COUNCIL

The Kent County Council (High Street and North Street, Headcorn) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that on 19th June 1975 the Kent County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at Headcorn:

At all times in—

(a) High Street

(i) on the north side from its junction with North Street for 15 yards eastwards to the entrance of No. 3 High Street;

(ii) on the south side from its junction with North Street for 75 yards eastwards to the east wall of "Chequers".

(b) North Street

(i) on the west side from its junction with High Street to the southern boundary of the White Horse Public House car park;

(ii) on the east side from its junction with High Street for a distance of 55 metres in a northerly direction;

(iii) on the east side from a point in line with the southern boundary of the White Horse Public House car park for a distance of 29 metres in a southerly direction.

Waiting limited to 30 minutes in any hour on the east side of North Street from 29 metres south of a point in line with the southern boundary of the White Horse Public House car park to a point 55 metres north of its junction with High Street.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait with police permission or for passengers to board or alight, for the loading or unloading of goods, for enabling works to be carried out in or adjacent to the road and for disabled persons.

A copy of the Order which will operate from 25th June 1975 and a map showing the roads concerned may be inspected during normal office hours at Room 1.97, County Hall, Maidstone.
